

Rules of the event:

Dress code:

The costume and equipment to claim to participate at the event will scrupulously have to respect the period 1466-1477.

Of course, you need a reenactment costume, hand-sewn.

The fashions, the materials, the construction, the shoes, the social standing will have to correspond to this period.

As for the material, whatever it's civil or military, every element will have to arise from an archaeological, iconographic or textual source.

For any participation, ONE OR SEVERAL PHOTOS OF YOUR COSTUME AND YOUR EQUIPMENT must be sent at the same time as your registration form.

Men's clothing:

Underwear:

White or ecru linen shirt and braies.

Headgear:

Wearing a headdress is obligatory. It has to respect the fashion of the period.

Doublet:

No sleevless doublet, no XIVth cotehardie, etc.

Hoses:

Not separated hoses respecting the assembly of 1470 and not 1490. For the separate hose, according to your social standing.

Shoes and accessories:

Leather shoes (rubber soles forbidden), encircles with historical buckles. Pouches only if copy of excavation or iconography, etc.

Mantel, cloak, hood:
They must be sources. Hood with fringes forbidden for Burgundian.
Miscellaneous:
No badges of company, blazon, embroidery evoking another party than those evoked for Brancion 1475.
Women's clothing:
Underwear:
Linen long shirt and short linen or woolen stockings. The modern underwear is accepted provided that it's not visible through the costume.
Cotte:
Linen or woolen, according to the status and the fashion of the 1470's.
Gown:
ld.
Headdress:
Obligatory, linen.
Shoes and accessories :
Id. men's clothing.
Children's clothing:
Kid will also have to wear a costume adapted for the event.

Armament:

Due to safety reasons, you will have to supply photos of your armament with your registration.

FORBIDDEN:

- cotton shirt of color,
- modern prescription glasses,
- no tattoo or piercing visible,
- no colored hair if not natural colors,
- no rubber soles, etc.
- weapons not blunted for the fight,
- ANY VISIBLE MODERN ELEMENT.

On the spot, the organizers reserve the right to refuse a part of a costume if it does not correspond to the required demands of historicity, or to refuse a participation if the equipment of a person does not correspond to rules quoted above.

Camp requirements:

Sleeping and eating:

The men as the women will have to carry with them a small linen bag, to collect their rations of food.

Flatware will have to be sourced.

The sleeping around will have to necessarily be historic, no sleeping bag, modern pillows, etc.

Behavior:

During the fights, any behavior considered as dangerous will immediately be sanctioned and the participant forbids to participate in the following ones.

In registering, you accept those rules.
